On the road in your own region

Are you not allowed to travel to La Gomera, but in your own country? And do you want to do something fun that clears your mind from worries? Search for Sea-Glass yourself! It's not as easy to find as shells, but the tips below are a good start!

- 1. Just before the deepest point of low tide, is the best time to search. the whole shore is yours for a long time.
- 2. Go to a "dirty" beach, away from beach bars and cleaned beaches
- 3. Walk about a meter along the tide line, but ...
- 4. Don't just walk in a straight line and ...
- 5. Preferably with the sun in your back
- 6. Don't look too close to your feet, not too tightly down. A few meters before your feet is better
- 7. Focus on shell banks and messy bits on the beach
- 8. Walk slowly and have patience, it takes time to train your eyes for this!
